


Kushiro City Garbage Sorting Book (Simplified version)

<Please dispose of garbage and recyclables by the designated time on the collection date. Check the collection date on the "Cleancalendar"!>

How to dispose	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Please put it in the designated garbage bag (yellow). Drain food waste well before putting it out. Soak cooking oil into the paper or cloth before discarding. Embers such as coal ash should be completely extinguished before discarding. Clothing other than 100% cotton should be disposed of in combustible garbage. <div style="border: 1px solid black; padding: 10px; background-color: #ffffcc;"> <p>Please put everything in the designated garbage bag. Items that protrude from the maximum size of the 40L designated garbage bag will be oversized garbage.</p> </div>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Put it in the designated garbage bag (blue). Wrap broken glass, knives, etc. in paper and label "fragile" or "dangerous" on the bag. <div style="background-color: #ccffff; padding: 10px;"> <p>Please put it in the designated garbage bag. However, in the case of a designated garbage bag with a maximum size of 40 liters, it can be collected even if it protrudes up to one-third. Anything that protrudes beyond that will be bulky garbage.</p> </div>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Dispose of mercury thermometers and dry cell in separate transparent bags. Please dispose of fluorescent lamps in the case in which they were purchased. Empty the contents of gas cylinders and spray cans, such as using up the contents, and then dispose of them without making holes. Empty the contents of disposable lighters, such as using up the contents, before throwing them away. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Items that do not fit in the designated garbage bag will be oversized garbage. Advance application is required, and there is no limit to the number of items to be thrown away. You will need a bulky garbage disposal ticket according to the number of garbage items to be thrown away. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Newspapers, magazines, and flyers should be bundled with paper string. Rinse the inside of paper packs (including those with spouts), dry them, and unfold them before discharging. Please put the cap and spout of the paper carton in the plastic container packaging. Paper cartons with a silver color inside are combustible garbage Rinse the white tray and PET bottle lightly and put it in a special bag. Be sure to remove the label and cap of the PET bottle and put it out in a plastic container and packaging. Rinse cans and bottles lightly and put them in a special basket. Please put miscellaneous paper in a special bag. Please bundle 100% cotton clothing and fabrics. Rinse the plastic containers and packaging lightly, put them in a transparent bag and place them in a special net. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Cut grass and fallen leaves should be placed in a transparent or translucent bag. Remove soil that adheres to the roots of the grass. Pruned tree branches should be no more than 50 cm long and bundled with string. Please write your name and put it out on Combustible Garbage Day. Please put it in the same place as combustible garbage. Please put it out in about 3 bags (bundles) at a time.




Recycling of televisions, refrigerators, washing machines, and air conditioners

1. Television (Cathode Ray Tube, Liquid Crystal, Plasma), refrigerators, freezers, washing machines, clothes dryers, and air conditioners cannot be collected by the city. Please recycle it in the following way.
